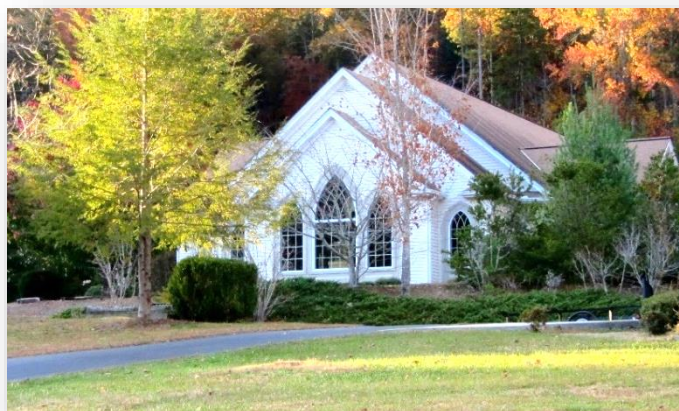

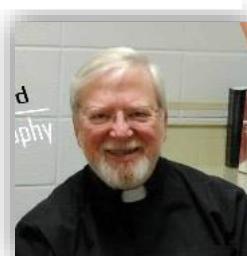

Poverty - Despair – Hopelessness

Dear Parishioners, your contributions to Saint Vincent de Paul are helping counteract poverty. But despair and hopelessness cannot be fixed by paying a bill alone. The SVdP team is made up of three people - two interviewers who aid with financial issues and one prayer person. At the beginning of each interview we explain our process and then ask if they would like to join us in prayer before they leave. We also note that it is not mandatory. 99.9% say yes. Upon completion of the intake process of offering aid, the client and the prayer person exit to a separate room for a confidential talk and prayer. That is where the Holy Spirit intervenes. The client, who typically is apprehensive during the intake process opens up to the prayer person and this helps lift the burdens they are carrying and reinforces the fact that someone truly cares. God’s love comes through our prayer person to them. This last segment of our intake is the most important part of the process. God’s message is LOVE, keep passing it on.
